

NWSC Ski Club Regulations and By-Laws

1. All members must obey the [Rules and Regulations of the National Water Sports Centre](#).
2. All boat drivers must observe the [Waterway Rules of the Club](#).
3. All boat members must provide a photo of the side of their boat showing the registration number, and annually provide a copy of their current boat insurance and ensure each item on the [Boat Safety Checklist](#) is attended to.
The member is responsible for any fines incurred for failure to do so.
4. All members must complete the sign-in register in the club house upon arrival and include their family members and visitors, whether skiing or not and whether using the club boat or not.
5. Only a member with club boat driving approval may drive the club boat. There must always be a member over age 18 years in the club boat at all times whilst in use. All children under age 10 years must wear a buoyancy vest whilst a passenger in any boat on the waterway. All boats towing a skier must have a competent observer.
6. To maintain control and safety on the water, eight boats only are allowed to park in the designated area at the club end of the waterway and must ski from this area only with three boats only allowed to operate on the water within each 1km area. Any boats over the eight are to moor outside the designated area (no skiing) until a parking spot becomes available in the designated area.
7. One ski-ride behind the club boat, which applies to member boats as well as when others are waiting, is 10mins, 4kms skiing or 6 slalom course passes. Therefore, there should be 5-6 payments per hour of club boat engine running time on the usage clock. The Skiing Fee must be paid at the time of skiing behind the club boat.
8. The Visitor Fee option is for occasional use only, therefore regular non-member users are unable to use this option and would need to join the Club as members. Members have priority over visitors in using the club boat. The Visitor Fee must be paid at the time of the visitor skiing which is the responsibility of the member they are with.
9. A list of membership boats is posted in the club house. A member must not use a non-membership boat. A member must not allow their boat to be used by a non-member. A member must not lend their keytag/card or keys to either a non-member or another member. The electronic gate must not be held or forced open.

Failure to observe these rules could result in suspension/cancellation of membership.
